DOG/CAT LICENSES

All dogs and cats must be licensed by January 31st. A late fee of \$2.00 monthly per animal will be enforced after that. Those who no longer own a dog or cat must notify the license official at 735 - 4107, ext. 106.

A dog license is \$5.00 if the animal is spayed/neutered, \$8.00 if not spayed/neutered. A cat license is \$3.00 if the animal is spayed/neutered, \$5.00 if not spayed/neutered.

To acquire an animal license, please send the following;

- ▶ proof of rabies vaccination (a dog's must be valid through November 1st)
- ▶ proof of spaying/neutering, if appropriate
- ▶ check made payable to the Township of Bethlehem
- ▶ a self-addressed stamped envelope for the return of the license
